Deuteronomy 18:15-20

GOD'S INTERPRETER

God speaks to us in different ways because we do not always listen the same. We experience God in our communion at church, in the simplicity of nature, in the sacred scriptures, and in the counsel of the wise. But God often uses another person to bring a message to us, because we cannot hear it on our own.

During their exodus from Egypt, the chosen people heard the words of God through Moses. They liked it that way. They thought if they heard God's word directly they would die. They needed an intermediary to shield them from the awesome power of God's presence.

God loved them and wanted them to hear the sacred words of the covenant. So God used Moses, and they listened to him.

God did even more for these people. God promised to give them another prophet from among their kin. God knew that in later generations, we would have the same problem. We do not always listen to God the same. We need someone to help us interpret.

In the fullness of time, God raised up a prophet like Moses. Jesus sits at God's right hand and intercedes for us. Human and divine, Jesus helps us hear God's word.

Sacred Heart History

1940's

Fr. Moore was transferred from the parish in October 1940. Father James McBarron arrived in the parish on October 15, 1940 to see to the completion of Fr. Moore's plan of repair and remodeling.

Fr. Kraka was moved from the parish in September of 1941 and Father William Engbers became the next assistant. Fr. Engbers took charge of activities for the teenage group. He reorganized the High School Club, trained Altar boys, and organized athletic activities for the grade school. He was transferred in August 1947.

Father James Dooley became the new assistant pastor in September 1947.
